There were thousands. the drummers led us and it took an hour for all the people to get into the cemetery....The driver is here (I am at Stedmans) He is consumed with guilt and needs to have someone with him all the time. Today at 3pm we are having a service for the young people to help them to debrief. The whole community is in shock. What happen was that the bus broke down and a bad decision was made to go in a smaller open truck. The truck was overloaded and the road in bad shape and the truck flipped over 3 times...So pray for us.
